## Why Ministry of Agriculture?

In accordance with Cabinet Regulation No. 217 The Ministry of Agriculture, in cooperation with LVMI Silava and the LUA, is preparing an annual inventory and forecast report on GHG emissions for LULUCF and agricultural sectors, as well as contributing to the implementation of the climate policy implementation documents



### Task 1: Development of supplements for national climate strategies and action plans (lead partner MA)

• The Task is aimed at:

implementation of the Project results in relevant policies, strategies and action plans in Baltic States and improvement of CCM related strategies in Germany and Finland

**support to national and regional authorities** in implementation of CCM measures in the national and regional strategies and action plans **to fulfil EU and national CCM targets** in post-2020 period in LULUCF and agriculture sectors

- Contribution to the CCM targets in 2013-2020 will be based on experience summarised in "Report on current situation – applied EFs and projections of GHG emissions from organic soils" and "Report on the identified CCM targeted management practices on organic soils" (Action A1).
- Contribution to the CCM targets in 2021-2030 will be based on the Project results, summarised in the report "Improved methodologies for National GHG inventory reports and related documents" (Action C1), reports on "Activity data for accounting & projections of GHG emissions from organic soils", "On integration of climate scenarios and projections of GHG emissions from organic soils" (Action C2) and scientific publications elaborated by the Project team.



## How it will be achieved?

- Action A2. Task 2: Development of Stakeholder network
- International expertise (experts) on accounting plans and on improvements of sectoral strategies; participation of external experts in national workshops, international conference; presentations, training; sessions.
- Organization of national workshops on climate change mitigation measures for fertile organic soils (2 different target groups addressed events per country), experts from other countries participate

Improvements adopted in National forestry accounting plans and forest management reference levels in Baltic countries

Improvements adopted in National LULUCF action plan progress reports in Baltic countries and Finland

Improvements adopted in Biannual reports and national reporting in Baltic countries

Improvements adopted in GHG emissions and CO<sub>2</sub> removals due to cropland and grassland management
